### **Events Sustainability Policy**

The Royal Docks team works in accordance with Event Sustainability Management System standard ISO20121. As part of this work we are seeking to improve sustainability across our events and demonstrate our commitment to continuous improvement.

In summary, this includes sustainability measures across all elements of our event production. This involves: separating and reducing waste; lowering energy usage; site protection; minimising deliveries to lower carbon footprint; encouraging contractors to pay London's Living Wage; encouraging visitors' use of public transport; using recyclable/recycled materials; making our events as accessible as possible, and more besides.

As such we will allocate the trading opportunity by priority to those who:

- Are able to demonstrate the sustainability of their produce and business as a whole
- Fully comply with the terms and conditions (submission of correct, full, accurate and up to date documentation)

In the event that more applications are received than available spaces, an evaluation process will be undertaken.

The operator will be selected from the received applications for the quality of their menu, originality and affordability. The aim throughout will be to ensure a high-quality offer to the public, that will enhance the overall offer of Kids Summer Splash 2019.

- Health & Safety Risk Assessment
- PAT test certificates of all electrical equipment to be brought to site
- Gas safety certificates of all gas-burning equipment to be brought to site
- Copy of your public liability insurance for £5 million
- Range of your product pricing
