

Pin and Whoosh set out for a wintery walk in the Royal Docks.


Pin was excited to show VVhoosh some of their favourite discoveries.

"They stay here all winter" said Pin.


"I can hear them snoring!" said Whoosh.






Then Whoosh wanted to share something special with Pin too.








Swoosh came the wind.
